

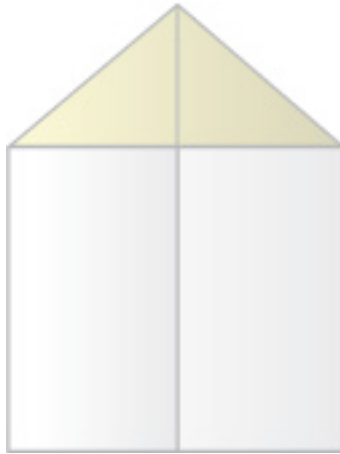
Step 1:

Fold your paper lengthwise and reopen.



Step 2:

Fold the top two corners toward the middle until the edges meet.



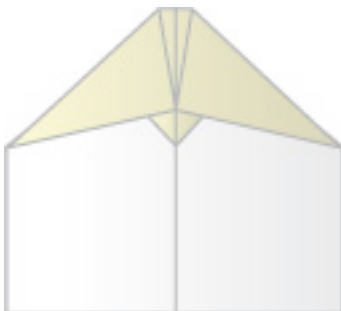
Step 3:

Fold the large triangle down so that the flaps from step 2 are tucked underneath.



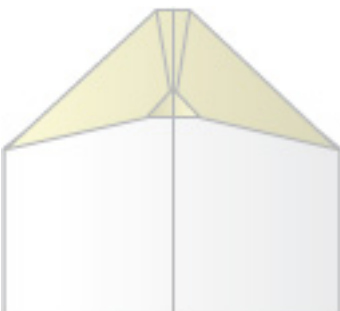
Step 4:

Fold the top two corners down to a point on the center crease about about 1½ inches above the tip of the triangle.



Step 5:

Fold the tip of the bottom triangle up until its edges meet the edges on the flaps from step 4.



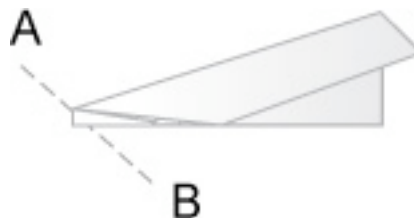
Step 6:

Fold along the center line so that the small triangle is on the outside of the plane.



Step 7:

Fold one flap down on each side, making sure to match the lowest corner of each to form wings of equal size.



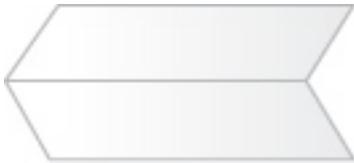


Paper airplane instructions

Option B

Step 1:

Fold the paper lengthwise in half.



Step 2:

Fold the top corners down to the middle crease until the edges meet, but do not overlap.



Step 3:

Fold the outer, top corners to the center, again folding until the edges meet.



Step 4:

Refold the paper with the new fold in the middle as shown in step 3.



Step 5:

Fold down each side of the paper, matching the lower corners to keep the wings an equal size.
