



## Prayer walking made simple

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While there is no right or wrong way to prayer walk (except maybe walking with your eyes closed), here are a few simple things to consider as you prayer walk.

Look for things to pray for as you walk. If you see toys in the front yard, you'll know that children live in the house. A wheelchair ramp will tell you a disabled person or elderly person lives there.

Be sensitive to God's prompting as you come across people. Maybe you are the one who God has placed there to simply talk with them.

As you pass people, greet them with a smile and warm hello. Let them know you are praying for the neighborhood and ask if they have a specific request.

As you walk through neighborhoods, pray that God will allow the seeds of the Gospel to be planted in each of the houses you pass.

Pray for families to love one another, pray for them to encourage one another, and pray that as a family they will come to know and serve Jesus.
