

# China/Taiwan fact sheet

Taiwan is an island located to the east of China. Most of the people who live in Taiwan are Chinese.

Taiwan has religious freedom similar to what can be found in the United States. Although Taiwan has many Christians and churches, it also has many people who follow other religions and worship idols.

China has limited religious freedom. The government allows Chinese people to worship in government-authorized churches only. But churches, Bibles and believers are scarce in China. Many people in China still have not heard the Gospel and most do not know how to get a Bible. People often worship in secret to protect themselves and their families.

The Lims, described in this video, are Chinese-Americans living in Taiwan. They hope to reach Chinese people – in China, in Taiwan and in other places in the world – with the Gospel. They created an evangelism tool. But this tool is not limited to use just among Chinese people. It can be used anywhere around the world with anyone!
