Dear Parents,

Have you ever been to Greece or wanted to go? It's a beautiful country filled with ancient wonders.

Many people from other nations are gathering in Athens, Greece, and other European cities, much like they are in the U.S. They usually don't know the language and some are refugees trying to start a new life. Christian workers use Bible stories to help them learn a new language, but also learn about Jesus.

Ask your child some of the ways they have prayed for the missionaries and the people who are learning about Jesus. Will you commit to pray together?

Does your family know someone who speaks another language? Try to get to know them and pray for ways to share Jesus with them. You can look online or at a Christian bookstore for Bibles in different languages. Plan to bring one to them and be intentional about sharing the stories from the Bible with those around you.
