are already discovering the blessing of giving every part of themselves to the Lord.

The focus verse in this KOM package is Matthew 22:37-39: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and most important commandment. The second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.”

Read this verse together as a family and discuss ways that you are or are not totally surrendered to Christ. We encourage you to tell your kids about your own spiritual journey and the blessings of following the Lord.

Visit an Indian restaurant for a cultural experience.
