More than 2 million migrant workers move from place to place in Thailand, building makeshift housing so their families can live near the current job site. Kids on Mission are learning about the lifestyle of migrant families and the difficulties caused by life on the move.



A team of International World Changers (IWC) recently visited migrant settlements in Thailand to teach kids, present evangelical dramas and help the Christian workers who live there. With your child, check out the latest list of mission opportunities at imbstudents.org. Ask your child which mission project sounds the most interesting, the most challenging or the most rewarding.

Ask your kids about Olivia, who obeyed her call to missions by going on the IWC trip to Thailand. How can your kids be obedient to share Christ with others?

Kids also talked about how families move in and out of your community. Consider ways your family can make new families feel welcome at church and in your neighborhood. Make it possible for your child to invite and bring new friends to visit your church.
