Hands On is a ministry for students and young adults to serve for one semester (four-five months) alongside a missionary in another country.



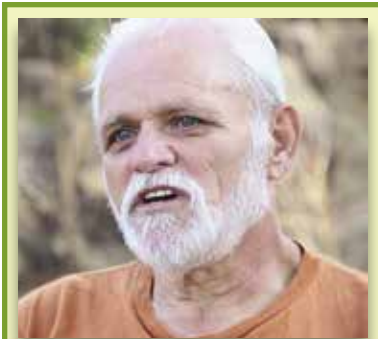
Elaine, volunteer
