Parent letter



Dear Parents,

More than 100 people groups live in the Amazon region. Most of those groups number less than 1,000 people. Some are hard to reach geographically; some are hard to reach spiritually. Those obstacles are being overcome by committed Christians who believe that no community, no matter how remote, should miss the opportunity to hear about Jesus.

Here are some ideas to learn along with your child:

Our featured missionaries use storytelling to communicate God's love and God's plan with people who have never heard or used the Bible before. Make a habit of reading Bible stories — the obscure along with the familiar — with your child, for enjoyment as well as education. Read dramatically. Laugh at the funny bits! Encourage younger kids to dramatize or illustrate what you read.

Let your child take the lead in a week's worth of meal planning and grocery list preparation. As you make the list, circle the items that are convenience foods or fully/partially prepared. Discuss what it would be like to plan meals Jansen-family

style: everything from scratch with a single grocery store run every four to six weeks.
