

Who's There? Parent letter



Dear Parents,

Missionaries don't share the gospel with *countries*, they share it with *people*! Kids on mission have learned how missionary kid DJ and his family live in Canada so that they can tell people of South Asian heritage the good news of Jesus. DJ and his mom traveled to South Asia to discover Christians there are doing the same thing!

Here are some ways your family can be on mission among the people in your neighborhood:

- Take time out for a meal together at a restaurant that serves food from India or another South Asian country. If you like to cook together, fire up the blender and make *lassi* with 2 cups of plain yogurt, ½ cup of water and milk, and 3 tablespoons of sugar. Top with sliced almonds and cardamom. Serve to friends and neighbors!
- Kids discovered that sharing Jesus can be as easy as playing in the park! Pack a picnic and allow your child to invite some friends. During down time, enthusiastically tell a Bible story, or let kids watch a Christian video on your phone or tablet.



Help your child become comfortable talking about his faith in Jesus. Make a small set of index cards containing questions about spiritual things: *What is your favorite Bible story? What is something that is always true about God? What is one reason you love Jesus?* Play a favorite board game together, but to earn a turn, each player must draw a card and answer the question.
