

# A Fun-filled Journey Parent letter



Dear Parents,

Would you consider a family vacation to Europe the trip of a lifetime? For one Oklahoma family, being part of a mission team in Poland was a trip with *eternal* lifetime impact! Ask your kids to tell you what they learned about the family that went to Poland.

This month's **focus verse** is Psalm 145:4 — *One generation will declare your works to the next and will proclaim your mighty acts.* Help your child discover the precious spiritual resources available to you through Christian seniors at your church. Make a special point for your family to worship alongside senior adults. Invite a grandma or grandpa to lunch or dinner. Encourage lots of *what was it like when* storytelling!

It has been argued that the Polish language is one of the hardest languages to master: the pronunciation, spelling and grammar mystifies English speakers! The Oklahoma mission team spent evenings socializing with their new Polish friends and attempting to master some of the tricky terms.
