Directions: Read the following facts. Encourage your children to choose True (step to the right) and False (step to the left).

- A lion is the national symbol of the city of Jerusalem. (TRUE-RIGHT)
- The Jewish people make up a small portion of the population of Jerusalem. (FALSE-LEFT; The Jewish people make up more than half the population)
- Jesus died on a cross, rose from the dead, and went up to heaven. All of these events happened in Jerusalem. (TRUE-RIGHT)
- King David built the temple that housed the ark of the covenant in Jerusalem. (FALSE-LEFT; King Solomon built the temple.)
- Falafel, a popular food in Jerusalem, is made of waffle. (FALSE-LEFT; Falafel is made of chickpeas and spices.)
- Jerusalem is a holy city for three of the worlds main religions: Judaism, Christianity and Islam. (TRUE-RIGHT)
- It snows in Jerusalem (TRUE-RIGHT; Jerusalem is located in the Judean mountains. In the winter it can get cold enough to snow!)
- Everything in the city of Jerusalem is new and modern. (FALSE-LEFT; Jerusalem is one of the most ancient cities in the world.)
